Why choose School Direct?

School Direct courses last an academic year and result in qualified teacher status (QTS), along with a PGCE.

You'll train in at least two good schools, getting the chance to learn 'on the job' – but you shouldn't worry about being thrown in at the deep end. You'll be part of a team from the very start, receiving intensive support from experienced teachers and mentors. That means you won't be teaching classes unsupported until the school thinks you're ready.

The principles of academic rigour on School Direct are the same as on university-led courses, too. You're also equally eligible for a [training bursary or scholarship](#) and can apply for the same financial support, such as student loans.

Participating schools will work in partnership with ITT providers to recruit their own trainees allowing schools to train teachers in subjects that meet their needs. With this in mind there is a possibility that successful trainees may go on to work in one of the schools in which they were trained, although there is no absolute guarantee of employment at the end of the training.
